Thomas Becket

Thomas Becket is former chancellor of England and friend of the king. After his appointment as archbishop he advocates for the church against the king's wishes. When the play begins he has returned from exile, expecting retribution.

Becket struggles with his own pride and his desires for martyrdom. He must confront that he wants the glory of sainthood and make peace with his death. He accepts God's will and is murdered by four knights inside the cathedral.
