## OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAMME

The Student Induction Programme – 2025 at Cardamom Planters' Association College, Bodinayakanur proved to be an enriching and highly impactful initiative for the newly admitted undergraduate students. Spanning five structured days of interactive sessions, departmental briefings, and resource awareness modules, the programme successfully met its intended objectives and yielded several noteworthy outcomes in terms of student integration, institutional awareness, and holistic engagement.

### 1. Seamless Student Transition and Integration

The primary goal of the SIP was to ease the transition from school to college. This comprehensive awareness not only empowered the students to navigate the institution more efficiently but also motivated many to actively join clubs and committees.

### 3. Academic Preparedness and Direction

Sessions on goal setting, self-employment, competitive exams, and employability skills were instrumental in guiding students toward clear academic and career objectives. Expert talks by professionals such as Dr. R. Kalirajan, Dr. M. Manoharan, Prof. N. Sugumaran, and Mr. R. Muthuganeshan helped students understand the practical relevance of their academic journey, including the importance of communication, planning, and self-discipline.

#### 4. Enhanced Moral, Social and Civic Responsibility

Sessions such as “A Crime-Free Life” by Mrs. K. Krishnaveni, and “Awareness of Indian Laws” by Mr. M. Venkatraman, significantly raised student awareness about legal rights, personal safety, and civic responsibility. Talks on anti-drug awareness, women’s rights, and environmental responsibility further instilled ethical values and a sense of social consciousness.

#### 5. Leadership and Personality Development

With dynamic sessions like “Winning is a Habit” and “The Art of Instilling Leadership Traits”, students were encouraged to take initiative, pursue excellence, and develop leadership skills. The resource persons connected well with the young audience through relatable narratives and practical wisdom. As a result, students showed enhanced self-confidence and a willingness to engage in leadership roles within student bodies.

#### 6. Active Faculty and Student Interaction

The involvement of over 30 faculty members across departments, clubs, and committees fostered early rapport between staff and students. This interaction laid the foundation for mentorship, academic support, and long-term engagement, which is crucial for student retention and success.

#### 7. Overall Programme Effectiveness and Reach

**Reach:** All 342 first-year students attended the sessions across disciplines, ensuring 100% reach within the target group.

**Effectiveness:** Feedback from students revealed that the sessions were relevant, motivational, and practically useful. Many expressed appreciation for the wide variety of topics and the quality of speakers.

**Engagement:** The inclusion of interactive Q&A sessions, feedback forms, and student reflections helped make the programme student-centric and responsive.
